Tom Jackson

I would add that this, this soil nailing process has been a godsend for slope stabilization projects. It helped us out on Tongore Road in Marbletown and up in Shandaken. It's helped us out tremendously. It's a real cost saving methodology. So, we would like to continue this.

I just came out of my Laws, Public Safety and Law Enforcement meeting where the Sheriff spoke on this. It's been five years since they did the upgrade. An upgrade is needed now. I guess this scan thing does like fingerprinting. And he said, God forbid it should ever go down. The Sheriff's Department you know when their business as usual be crippled. It is \$125,000. Any discussion?

I did just want to mention that they also said that this is used by other towns and, you know, villages. And other police agencies come in and use it, as well. Because it's an expensive piece of equipment and it gets utilized by more than just the county. So, it's a kind of like a good deal for us to have available to them.

So, your saying other towns, they go to the sheriff's department.

I will say one thing on old business. I had mentioned several months ago about an area on Route 299 has been a concern of the local people and a lot of constituents. And I see that the Ulster County Planning has sent a letter, on my behalf, to the Department of Transportation. And they also did a pill study. And I believe in the last five years there's been fifty-nine accidents along that stretch of road that is about, not even 1000 feet long. Maybe it is 1000 feet long. And I just

wanted to acknowledge that the Ulster County Planning Board had done that. And UCTC has also cc'd on that. So, we're getting some movement there. And it's a dangerous corridor that needs to be addressed, and I appreciate their efforts.

Chairman Fabiano

Okay, any other old business?

That's okay, I just wanted to ask if Herb had gone on a field trip. I believe I may be getting the projects, mixed up, you probably know what I'm referring to.

Legislator Litts

You're probably referring to the watering proposal, watering system for the expansion of the Veteran Cemetery in New Paltz. I did not go a field trip. We had talked about going on a field trip, but it was felt that with the COVID going around. I did get a response from Dennis Doyle. He sent the request to the consultant of record. They went out, they looked at it, and came back with many reasons why the proposal I had put forth to be looked at would not work. So, I guess that is fine. You know, they answered the questions. I don't know, I thought they could have done a little more but it's... I think it's fine. Thank you for remembering that.
