

AMENDING THE 2004 ULSTER COUNTY BUDGET TO ADD EXECUTIVE SECRETARY TO TRAFFIC SAFETY BOARD

The Criminal Justice / Public Safety / STOP DWI Committee (Chairman Meyer and Legislators Aiello, DePew, Every, Dart, Feldmann and Hyatt) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature has by local law established a Traffic Board under Article 43, Section 1672 of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, and

WHEREAS, Article 43 requires that the Traffic Safety Board appoint an executive secretary who shall be the executive and administrative officer of the board, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law specifies that the county may authorize the employment of personnel as may be necessary to properly perform the functions and carry out the objectives of Article 43, and

WHEREAS, it necessary to provide an Executive Secretary part time position to the Ulster County Traffic Board to provide administrative support for the program, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice/Public Safety/STOP DWI Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the position of Executive Secretary to the Traffic Safety Board (Grade 13), part time non-benefitted at \$18.12 hourly is hereby authorized, and
