The Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee (Chairman Felicello and Legislators Hathaway, McAfee, Meyer, Stock, Berardi, Donaldson, Provenzano and Zimet) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the increased price of gasoline and diesel fuel for Ulster County vehicles has dramatically occurred during the last twelve months, and

WHEREAS, heavy flooding has caused highway and bridge washouts throughout Ulster County contributing to the unusual increase in fuel usage for the construction and reconstruction of Ulster County's highways and bridges, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County has expended 100% of stockpile funds for gasoline fuel in the amount of \$359,678.00 for highway and bridge uses and approximately 50% or \$113,034.00 of its vehicle diesel fuel allocations, and

WHEREAS, total estimates for the cost of vehicle fuel will be approximately \$870,500.00 for the year 2005, of which \$590,500.00 is currently budgeted, leaving an additional requirement for \$280,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Controller of the Public Works Administration and the Commissioner of Highways and Bridges request an additional amount of \$280,000.00 for the purchase of fuel, and

WHEREAS, the Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
