Unpaid School Taxes For The School Year 2008 - 2009

The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Lomita and Legislators Cahill, Dart, Gregorius, Provenzano, Zimet, Cummings, Gerentine and Noonan) offers the following:

RESOLVED, that the accounts of unpaid school taxes for the year 2008 – 2009 reported to the Ulster County Treasurer and laid before this Board of Legislators pursuant to Section 1330, paragraph 5 of the Real Property Tax Law, be accepted and it is hereby directed that the amounts of such unpaid taxes (less the amount of 2008 – 2009 School Taxes which the owner has paid to the Ulster County Treasurer on or before November 21, 2008) with seven (7) per centum of the amount of principal and interest in addition thereto, be received upon the real property upon which the same were imposed and when collected the same shall be returned to the Ulster County Treasurer to reimburse the County for the amount so advanced with expense of collection, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay the officer charged by law with the custody of school district monies of the County appropriated there from the amount of the returned unpaid school taxes in accordance with the provisions of Section 1330, paragraph 4 of the Real Property Tax Law,

and moves its adoption.
