WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Laws and Rules Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to execute, on behalf of the County, a revocable License Agreement, the terms and conditions thereof which shall be subject to the negotiation, review and approval of the County Attorney, and, as shall thereafter, be filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, as approved by the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
