The Economic Development, Housing, Planning and Transit Committee (Chairman Rodriguez and Legislators Berardi, Gregorius, Loughran, Sheeley, Alfonso and Roberti) offers the following:

WHEREAS, Phase I of the Ulster County Transit Center Project, located at Golden Hill Drive, Kingston, New York, was authorized for the preliminary engineering, design, site preparation, and incidental preliminary costs in the amount of \$1,240,624.00 pursuant to Resolution No. 158 dated April 11, 2002, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 232 of August 26, 2003 authorized Capital Project No. 248 (H4-1699-9248-0000) to be amended to increase it by an additional \$6,005,322.00 to \$7,245,946.00 to include the additional site preparation, off site construction for utilities and building construction for the Ulster County Transit Center Project, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 375 of December 13, 2004 authorized Capital Project No. 248 (H4-1699-9248-0000) to be amended to increase it by an additional \$157,895.00 to \$7,403,841.00 to complete the Ulster County Transit Center Project, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 304 of November 10, 2005 authorized Capital Project No. 248 (H4-1699-9248-0000) to be amended to transfer funds in the accounts to complete the Ulster County Transit Center Project, and

WHEREAS, this funding has been obligated by the Federal Transit Administration and the New York State Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the project is completed with 80% federal and 10% state funding, and

WHEREAS, Phase II of the project is completed with 80% federal and 10% state funding, and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend Phase III, for the fueling system, construction of second floor ceilings, floors, bathrooms, work space and tire shed, purchase of some moveable equipment such as a floor cleaner, art project, a monument-type sign identifying the building and miscellaneous small purchases needed to make the building operational, and
