WHEREAS, the Director of Ulster County Probation has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement, being said contract (T914230) in the amount of \$43,586.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to participate in the Federal Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) project to enhance Operation IMPACT by providing support for a Field Intelligence Officer position, and

WHEREAS, a half-time Field Intelligence Officer will work to improve County Intelligence and Crime Analysis Teams (ICAT) by ensuring that all participating Operation IMPACT agencies are fully invested and equipped to participate as part of the team, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Project No. BJ06-1118-D00, is a Federal Pass-thru DCJS State Project No. BJ05914230 which will be administered over a one year period, starting January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007, and

WHEREAS, federal funds will support 90% of the cost of the project and must be matched by a local cash match of 10% of the total project cost, in the amount of \$4,359.00, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, being said contract (T914230) in the amount of \$43,586.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to participate in the Federal Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Project for the period of January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and
