WHEREAS, the Coordinator of the Department of Environment shall have the authority to appoint and remove all employees of the Department of the Environment, except as such power and authority is specifically limited by local law or New York State statute, and

WHEREAS, commencing January 1, 2009, the Coordinator of the Department of the Environment shall be appointed by the County Executive subject to confirmation of the County Legislature and such appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the County Executive, and

RESOLVED, that Amanda LaValle Genson be and hereby is appointed as Coordinator, Department of the Environment, effective February 20, 2008, term to expire December 31, 2008, at an annual salary of \$48,363.00,
