FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Resource Allocation Plan be filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature and after it has been so filed, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute such plan along with Commissioner of Ulster County Social Services for the year 2005,
